Certificate Course in Dental Orthodontics

The Certified Course in Dental Orthodontics is designed to provide individuals with the specialized skills and knowledge required to function effectively as technicians or assistants in dental orthodontic practices. This six-month program focuses on the technical aspects of orthodontics, including orthodontic materials, appliance fabrication, and chairside assistance.

Program Objectives

- To provide comprehensive training in orthodontic materials and techniques.
- To develop skills in orthodontic appliance fabrication and repair.
- To impart knowledge of dental anatomy and occlusion relevant to orthodontics.
- To instill a strong foundation in chairside assistance and infection control.
- To prepare graduates for entry-level positions in dental orthodontic practices.

Course Layout and Scheme of Study

First three months basic dental knowledge regarding instrumentation, equipment and infection control will be delivered. For next three months specialized clinical skills b will be taught.
